RICHARD V. McDUGALL, BOARD INVESTIGATOR

Richard McDougall ("Mac"), the person many believe has historically had the most positive influence on the practice of physical therapy in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in 1988 completed a 3rd appointment/9 yrs as a member of the Board of Physical Therapy. He continues to provide expertise to the Board by serving (through contract) as a primary investigator of complaints and as a monitor to persons whose license is on probation.

As the first Director of the Program in Physical Therapy at the University of Kentucky, Lexington, Mac worked diligently to recruit excellent faculty and students, provide a sound education, and then prompt those physical therapists to return to rural areas of this state as well as to practice in more common "choice" urban areas. His first appointment to the Board followed many years of KPTA leadership, including multiple terms as State Chapter President. In recognition of his dedication and talents, his Kentucky colleagues bestowed their "Outstanding Physical Therapist" award upon him, and he received the national "Lucy Blair Award" for outstanding service. Mac brought his same zeal for the highest standards in physical therapy to the State Board of Physical Therapy, and consequently many people feel this agency, blessed with being able to function under a sound

law and Board members such as Mac, is one of the more responsible Physical Therapy Boards in our nation.

Although the Board 1st adopted a "Standards of Practice Guidelines" in 1975, strict enforcement of the Standards came to full fruit during Mac's terms. Currently, 3 board members, Mac, and the executive secretary have completed the National Certified Investigator Training (NCIT) course sponsored by the Council on State Governments. Licensees and the public can be assured that Board Members will fulfill their obligation to enforce KRS 327 and Board regulations and, as charged in KRS 327.040 investigate each signed, written complaint received.

Mac also continues to serve physical therapy licensure on a National level, recently being reelected to his third term as Treasurer of the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy. He was instrumental in laying the groundwork for the Federation in which Kentucky proudly holds ('87) Charter Membership. In 1993, the transition of ownership of the licensure examination for PTs & PTAs from the APTA to the FSBPT will be complete! We appreciate Richard McDougall for helping to pave the way.

ENFORCEMENT
MANDATES & ACTIVITIES

KRS 327, "The Physical Therapy Practice Act" was enacted in 1958 to ensure to the public that the physical therapy services they receive are provided by competent, ethical persons. Entry level competency is, of course determined jointly thru graduation from an accredited program in physical therapy plus passing the National Physical Therapy Licensure Examination, currently provided to licensure boards by ASI.

The Board is charged in KRS 327.040 with enforcing the provisions of KRS 327, including investigating every supposed violation "coming to its notice", and to "establish by regulation a code of ethical standards and standards of practice". The standards, first adopted by reference in 1975, are now a regulation, 201 KAR 22:053. One Ethical Standard, required of both PTs and PTAs in Section 2 (4) is to "Report unethical, incompetent, or illegal acts to the board". The number one source of complaints is licensees. Complaints initiated by the Board itself comes second, those from the consumer, third, and fourth, notices of malpractice settlements from the National Practitioner Data Bank.

Follow these guidelines if you wish to file a complaint concerning a physical therapist, physical therapist's assistant or other person who is holding him/herself out as being able to practice as a physical therapist or assistant (usually through advertising or billing using the term "physical therapy", etc):

- 1) The complaint must be specific, written, and signed.
- 2) The accused person's full name, address, & telephone number (if available) is to be provided.
- 3) DO NOT SEND undocumented statements/hearsay which can not be investigated.
- 4) State clearly the alleged infraction. Cite the statute number, regulation or standard in question. Enclose any available evidence. Complaints concerning TV ads are to be accompanied by a videotape of the Ad.
- 5) You must be willing to testify at a hearing, if necessary.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES, 1985 PRESENT

A large number of complaints have been received in the past by the board concerning PTs, PTAs, potential applicants for licensure or certification, and a wide range of others who are alleged to be in violation of KRS 327.020 (3) which states in part, "It shall be unlawful...to use in connection with his or its name or business activity the words "physical therapy," "physical therapist"...the letters "P.T." or "LPT" or any other words, letters...indicating...that physical therapy is provided or supplied or to bill for physical therapy unless such physical therapy is provided by or under the supervision of a physical therapist licensed and practicing in accordance with this chapter." Violations of 327.020 (3) are first addressed through the issuance of a "Cease and Desist" letter from the office of the Attorney General. Only once, in 1985, has the Board had to take a person (physician) to court to obtain compliance. 41 other cases have been resolved with less difficulty.

Since 1985, complaints have also been lodged against 46 physical therapists, 10 physical therapist's assistants, or potential licensure or certification applicants alleging various violations of KRS 327 and the accompanying regulations. After an investigation and if required, hearing, the board has dismissed the complaint, refused to issue or renew a license, revoked, suspended or placed a license on probation, or issued an Administrative Warning to the licensee or certificiant. The majority of persons disciplined since 1985 have accepted disciplinary action through an "Agreed Order" which eliminates the need and expense of a hearing. As a result of the use of Agreed Orders, few hearings have ever had to be held. The results of the hearings included one PT's license being placed on monitored probation for 3 yrs, and another PT's license was revoked.
