5 RELATES TO: KRS 327.010

6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 327.040

7 CERTIFICATION STATEMENT: This is to certify that this administrative regulation complies
8 with the requirements of 2025 RS HB 6, Section 8.

9 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: The practice of physical therapy is rapidly
10 evolving and changing in purpose and scope. The purpose of this administrative regulation
11 is to define clearly the desired goals of physical therapy and the permissible means of
12 achieving these goals. In this manner, standards of physical therapy practice are clearly
13 established and may be used to evaluate particular treatments which have been used [,]or
14 which may later evolve.

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16 Section 1. Goals of the patient-physical therapy team [~~unit~~] include, but are not limited to,
17 maintaining health, preserving functional capacity, and in the presence of impairment,
18 developing or reestablishing function through carefully planned, and implemented
19 programs. In order to reach these objectives, the physical therapist provides consultation,
20 evaluates patients, identifies problems, plans programs, and provides direct treatment.

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2 Section 2. Patient Management. Adequate, effective, and efficient patient care is the
3 ultimate goal of physical therapy. The physical therapist evaluates each patient, and
4 determines those ways in which they [~~he~~] can contribute to total health management. The
5 physical therapist [~~He~~] then plans and implements a treatment program, reevaluating and
6 making modifications as necessary. A physical therapist shall refer to the appropriate [~~a~~]
7 licensed healthcare professional [~~physician or dentist~~] any patient whose medical
8 condition should, at the time of evaluation or treatment, be determined to be beyond the
9 scope of practice of the physical therapist. When basis for treatment is referral, the physical
10 therapist may confer with the referring licensed healthcare professional [~~physician,~~
11 ~~podiatrist, dentist, or chiropractor~~].
